

SKETCH CRAWL COLUMBUS

Schedule: (Join us for 20 minutes or spend the whole day):

- NOON-1:00 **1** meet n' eat at the **north market**—upstairs, east side (don't forget to draw your lunch!)
- 1:30-2:30 **2** **Statehouse Lawn** (northwest corner near Broad and High)
- 2:30-3:30 **3** **Statehouse Lawn** (southwest corner near State and High)
- 3:30-4:30 **4** **Riverfront-Santa Maria** (north of Broad Street Bridge)
- 4:30-5:30 **5** **Goodale Park Pond** (northeast corner of the park)
- 6:00 **1** back to the **north market** for dinner

*if weather becomes a factor, seek shelter. There's a lot to draw inside until the rain blows over.

6 simple steps for a successful sketchcrawl:

1. print this map, fold it neatly, and stick it in your back pocket.
2. grab a bag and stuff it with your favorite art supplies and sketchbook.
3. walk, bike, drive, swim or "COTA" your way to the various locations.
4. draw anything and everything—people, buildings, plants, statues, whatever catches your eye.
5. when the day is over, scan or photograph your drawings and upload them to the columbus sketch crawl group for all to enjoy. it's easy and free. (www.flickr.com/groups/columbussketchcrawl/).
6. there really isn't a sixth step. we needed one more to complete the alliteration.
